We welcome you back to Aachen's city center on December 31st 2025 for the traditional 'Aachener Silvestersterlauf' and look forward to ringing in the new year with you!


Alongside the three established races there will once again be an elite race this year, with all races taking place on a route through the historic city center:


- o Junior Cup, approx. 1.5 km (one lap), start 1:10 pm\*
- o AOK Fun Run, approx. 4.5 km (two laps), start at 1:40 pm\*
- J&J MedTech Speed Race\*\*, approx. 4.5 km (two laps), start 2:30 pm\*
- o Sparkasse Aachen Silvester Challenge, approx. 9.0 km (four laps), start 3:15 pm\*

AOK Fun Run, J&J MedTech Speed Race and Sparkasse Aachen Silvester Challenge will count for the Regio Aachen Cup. The results from the AOK Fun Run and J&J MedTech Speed Race are combined and counted as one race for the Regio Cup.

#### Route

The route takes you on a round course through Aachen's city center. A route starting at the market, then over Jakobstrasse and Bendelstrasse, past Aachen Cathedral and Elisenbrunnen and back to the market via the town hall, where the finish is also located is planned. The Junior Cup will be held on a shorter route over Johannes-Paul-II-. Street instead of Jakob- und Bendelstreet.

# Limitation of starting slots

For safety reasons, a maximum of 1000 runners can take part in the Fun Run and 1000 runners in the Silvester Challenge.

#### J&J MedTech Speed Race

The elite race over 4.5 km will take place again this year, giving the fastest participants the opportunity to prove their skills.

To take part in this race, you should be able to run 5 km in under 25 minutes.

There is prize money for the top three women and men (see "Awards and honors" section)!

#### Time limit

The finish time for the Silvester Challenge is 90 minutes after the start. After this time, the organizer reserves the right to lift existing route closures.

#### Awards and honours

# Starting number

A timekeeping chip is attached to the back of each race number. The start numbers must be worn visibly on the chest to ensure adequate timekeeping and must not be altered or covered. Personal data, contact persons and medical emergency information can be written on the back of the race number.

# Change of registration

A change of registration to another runner is possible on December 31 at the Infopoint. There is generally no refund of the entry fee.

# Changing rooms/showers

Showers and changing rooms are planned in the Minoritenstraße gym near the start and finish area.

# Preparation course

You want to take part but don't yet feel fit enough or would like some assistance in your preparation? No problem: sign up for our preparation course together with the run. You can join at any time.
